

COVID-19 POLICY & PROCEDURES

At Waterton Lakes Golf Course, our staff have been working hard to prepare the golf course for the 2021
 Season, and to develop and implement operational procedures and plans that conform to the Government's COVID-19 control measures.

The following is a list of safety measures implemented and enforced at our facility to comply with Provincial regulations regarding the opening of outdoor fitness, recreation and performance.

By making a tee time reservation, you agree to the listed terms and conditions below and attest that you and your playing partners are not experiencing any symptoms of the COVID-19 virus. If you experience any COVID-19 symptoms prior to your tee time reservation – you must stay home and cancel your tee time reservation.

Common COVID-19 related symptoms can include Fever, Dry Cough, Nasal Congestion, Runny Nose, Sore Throat and Diarrhea.

Masks are currently required in all indoor spaces. PHYSICAL DISTANCING of 2M/6FT is required AT ALL TIMES while on the property. This includes but is not limited to the following areas: the parking lot, pro shop, and all playing areas of the golf course, particularly on the tee box and greens.

The exception to this is while seated and consuming food and beverage in the clubhouse or on the patio.

PROVINCIAL LEGISLATION is enforceable under PUBLIC HEALTH ORDERS while you are on the property, Penalties and Fines apply. Anyone breaching or failing to comply with physical distancing protocols or any of the policies listed below will be subject to removal from the facility and may be banned until all such policies have been removed.

FACILITY ACCESS & OPERATIONS:

Patio & Restaurant will be open, Currently a maximum of 6 people are allowed while seated indoors per table. Tables whether indoors or out must be distanced by at least 2 meters.

- The Beverage Cart will operate based on traffic volume.
- The washrooms in the clubhouse will be open with enhanced cleaning and sanitization procedures.
- Portable toilets will be available on the course.
- A limited number of customers are permitted in the **Pro Shop** at a time, traffic is one way only and physical distancing markers are indicated on the floor.
- Advance tee time reservations are required. Tee times may be made on line or by phone. Call (403) 859-2114
- Bookings of 2, 3 and 4 golfers will be allowed, twosomes will be paired up during busy times. Single players will only be accommodated if there is space with previously booked twosome or threesome.
- Power carts & pull carts will be sanitized after every use.
- Hand Sanitizer stations are available in the Pro Shop; they <u>will not</u> be provided on the golf course so please bring your own personal hand sanitizer for use on the course.
- Tap Credit / Debit method is preferred payment for all transactions.

ARRIVAL AT THE GOLF COURSE:

- Players should arrive no more than 30 minutes before their round. All individuals will be checked in and
 receive a COVID-19 screening as well. Anyone who fails the screening will not be permitted entry and is
 required to leave the property.
- Only two customers are permitted in the Pro Shop at a time, if there are 4 people in line please remain outside until it is safe to enter.
- Please follow the floor arrows, stand on the physical distance indicator to check in and exit the Pro Shop safely.
- Please ensure the group in front of you has left the tee box before making your way there, all groups must wait until their assigned tee time before teeing off no exceptions!
- A scorecard and pencil will be made available 1 per group upon request.

AFTER COMPLETING YOUR ROUND:

- All power and pull cart rental equipment must be returned immediately to the appropriate return area.
- Please remove any refuse and deposit into garbage can in the return area. This will allow our staff to properly clean and sanitize the equipment quickly for the next customer.

• THINGS TO KEEP IN MIND:

- Physical distancing if 2M/6FT is required at all times, this includes with all staff interactions as well.
- Personal/Physical contact with any person before during or after your round is prohibited.
- Only touch your own personal items and golf equipment.
- These are the current rules and regulations and will be amended as directed by the Provincial Health
 Authorities. They are being enforced for your safety and that of our staff, their families and the general
 public.
